Rabbi Dr. Shlomo C. Pill is currently a Senior Fellow in Law and Religion and Post Doctoral Fellow at The Center for the Study of Law and Religion at Emory University, where he teaches courses on Jewish Law and Islamic Law. He received his JD from Fordham Law School, and LLM and SJD degrees from Emory Law School. His research focuses on Comparative Jewish, Islamic, American Law and Legal Philosophy, and the ways in which the teachings and values of nomos-centric religious traditions can be brought to bear on contemporary issues in American public life. Dr. Pill is also an associate rabbi at the New Toco Shul in Atlanta, GA, a licensed attorney, and is the director of the Institute for Jewish Muslim Action, an organization dedicated to developing and actualizing research-based cooperative initiatives between American Jews and Muslims to promote common goals.

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
