PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

EIKEV

1. G-d promises blessings and material success as the reward for observance of the Torah and Mitzvot.
2. The requirement to destroy the inhabitants of Cana'an and their idols.
3. The kindnesses G-d has done for the Children of Israel in the desert and the promise to bring them to the land of Cana'an.
4. The Mitzva of reciting a prayer to G-d after eating.
5. Words of rebuke recalling the golden calf, the ensuing breaking of the luchot - tablets of stone and Moshe's prayer that saved the nation from G-d's wrath.
6. The second set of luchot and the choosing of the Levi'im to serve in the Temple.
7. A review of the miracles G-d performed in the desert and words of praise about the Land of Cana'an.
8. The second portion of the Sh'ma and a further warning to observe the Torah and Mitzvot.

HAFTORAH

Today's Haftorah, is the second Haftorah of Consolation. The land and the people respond negatively to the message of consolation borne by the prophet: G-d has forsaken and forgotten about us (a direct communication from G-d without the prophet as intermediary is preferred). The content of today's parsha centered on belief in G-d and observance of the Torah. The prophet echoes these themes. The prophet promises that a new and improved nation of Israel (after the destruction and return to Zion) will be reunited with the land and G-d will turn the land he destroyed into a paradise and garden of G-d.

AIPAC Israel Update

Ambassador Haley Presses UNIFIL to Thwart Spread of Hezbollah Weapons

On Aug. 7, U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations (U.N.) Nikki Haley urged the U.N. Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) to increase its efforts to prevent Hezbollah from acquiring illegal weapons. Haley stated that the United States is seeking "significant improvements" to UNIFIL as the U.N. Security Council (UNSC) considers later this month the renewal of UNIFIL's mandate, set to expire on Aug. 31. "These arms which are almost entirely in the hands of Hezbollah terrorists threaten the security and stability of the region. UNIFIL must increase its capacity and commitment to investigating and reporting these violations," said Haley. Ambassador Haley's statement came in response to an Aug. 4 letter from U.N. Secretary-General Antonio Guterres to the UNSC regarding ways UNIFIL could potentially "enhance its efforts." "We share the Secretary-General's strong desire to enhance UNIFIL's efforts to prevent the spread of illegal arms in southern Lebanon," said Haley. "The United States will continue to raise the threat posed by Hezbollah as we seek significant improvements to UNIFIL when the Security Council renews its mandate this month."
