PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

VA'EIRA

1. G-d reminds Moshe about the covenant with the forefathers, and Moshe repeats this message to the deaf ears of the Israelites.
2. Moshe again doubts the success of his mission.
3. The family tree of the tribe of Levi, preceded by those of his older brothers, Reuven and Shimon.
4. Moshe's doubts continue, G-d encourages him.
5. Moshe and Aharon appear before Paroah and perform the three miracles G-d taught Moshe at the burning bush.
6. G-d brings seven plagues on the Egyptians: Blood-Frogs-Lice-Wild animals-Cattle disease-Boils and Hail. Before each plague, Paroah promises to release the Israelites, and with each salvation, he goes back on his word.

HAFTORAH

In today's Haftorah, the navi Yechezkel is told to prophecise to Egypt that G-d is preparing to punish and destroy Egypt for crimes committed against the monarchy of Judea. G-d will return the Jews to their land and they will thrive their once again (during the Second Temple period). These prophecies are parallel to the statements that Moshe is making to Paroah and the Jews in Egypt in our parsha.

AIPAC Israel Update

U.S. House Cheers Iran's Protests, Condemns Human Rights Violations

The U.S. House of Representatives overwhelmingly passed a resolution Tuesday supporting the Iranian people's right to free expression while condemning the country's leadership for crackdowns on recent protests, Voice of America reported. The 415-2 vote comes just days ahead of the beginning of a congressionally mandated 60-day window for lawmakers to address U.S. President Donald Trump's decision to not re-certify the 2015 Iran nuclear deal. At least 21 people have been killed in nationwide anti-government protests that began last month. "With the passage of this resolution, we state that America stands with the Iranian people," Representative Ed Royce, Chair of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, said Tuesday. The protests have since dwindled amid arrests of more than 3,700 people, according to one Iranian lawmaker. The demonstrations were the largest in Iran since the June 2009 "Green Revolution," triggered by a presidential election that protesters said was fraudulent.
