# PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

## PINCHAS

1. G-d rewards Pinchas for his actions - he becomes a Kohen, and the High Priesthood is given to his descendants.
2. The Israelites are commanded to avenge the conspiracy of the Midianites.
3. A census of the people counts 601,730 men between the ages of twenty and sixty. These are army eligible men who are preparing for the wars of conquest of the land of Canaan.
4. Moshe is instructed on how the land is to be divided by lottery among the tribes and families of Israel.
5. The daughters of Zelafchad petition Moshe to be able to inherit their father's land in Canaan. G-d amends the laws of inheritance to include daughters.
6. Yehoshua is formally appointed as the successor to Moshe.
7. The public korbanot (sacrifices), and the Mussaf korbanot - daily, Shabbat, Rosh Chodesh and the holy days.

## HAFTORAH

Today's Haftorah, is the first of the three Haftarot of Tragedy that are read on the three Shabbatot between Shiv'a Asar B'Tammuz and Tisha B'Av. These Haftarot foretell the destruction of the First Temple. Yirmiyahu, the prophet, uses the image of a rod and an open pot to deliver the message for God that punishment is near and the enemy will come from the north. The Haftorah ends with a message of hope: God will remember the way the nation followed Him through the desert for forty years, and any nation that will harm the Jewish people will eventually feel God's retribution.

### AIPAC Israel Update

#### Senate Appropriations Committee Supports Homeland Security Cooperation

On June 21, the Senate Appropriations Committee passed its Department of Homeland Security (DHS) appropriations bill, which includes funding for U.S.-Israel Homeland Security (HLS) cooperation. According to AIPAC's News Hub, should the relevant provision make it to the president's desk, Congress will have quadrupled its annual funding of U.S. - Israel non-defense programs in a period of just two years. The road to this unprecedented HLS funding began in 2014 when the U.S.-Israel Strategic Partnership Act authorized DHS to develop pilot programs with Israel. Following this, DHS initiated a three-year pilot with Israel's Ministry of Public Safety (MOPS) that supported first-responder and wearable technologies collaboration. With the pilot program now winding down, this year's congressional funding will provide funds for the long-term viability and growth of the program, and enable its expansion into the areas of cybersecurity, border security, maritime security, biometrics and video analytics.
