PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

RE'EH

1. Instructions for the ceremony of blessings and curses on Mt. Gerizim and Mt. Eival in the Land of Cana'an.
2. Laws about eradicating idol worship from the land and about bringing korbanot (sacrifices) only at the Temple.
3. Laws permitting the slaughter of animals for meat (non-sacrificial), and laws prohibiting the eating of blood.
4. Laws forbidding the copying of non-Jewish ways, customs, and practices.
5. Laws regarding false prophets, a person who seduces others to worship idols, and a perverse city - a city of Jews who have chosen to worship idols.
6. A review of the laws of kashrut: animals, fish, and fowl.
7. Laws for the Shemitta - sabbatical year for land and loans.
8. Laws of tzedakah and a review of the laws regarding a Jewish slave and maidservant.
9. The sanctity of the first-born animal.
10. The laws and details of the festivals.

HAFTORAH

Today's Haftorah is the third of the seven Haftarot of Consolation. The Haftorah opens with the report of the prophet to G-d: the city of Jerusalem will not accept the message of comfort as delivered by the prophet. The Haftorah reinforces the lesson of the parsha: A promise of blessings to those who keep the Torah and mitzvot. The moral influence of the Jewish people on the world will be so great that nations will come to study our ways and learn from us.

AIPAC Israel Update

Over 150 Rockets Launched Into Israel, Woman Seriously Injured

A woman was seriously injured in Israel early Thursday morning when a rocket launched from the Gaza Strip hit a home in the Eshkol regional council near the Palestinian enclave, the Times of Israel reported. The woman was a 30-year-old foreign worker from Thailand. She suffered injuries to her abdomen and limbs. Another person was lightly injured, and several were treated for shock. Thursday morning's injuries brought the total of wounded on the Israeli side to five in the current cycle of violence. Rocket barrages by the Hamas terror group continued throughout the night. The military said over 150 rockets and mortar shells were launched at Israeli communities since Wednesday evening. Most of the rockets hit open areas. The Iron Dome defense system, which targets only missiles projected to strike communities, destroyed 25 of the rockets. However, several hit homes and factories in Israeli communities, causing damage. One barrage that slammed into the city of Sderot Wednesday evening injured three Israelis. At least eight others were treated for panic attacks, including two pregnant women who went into labor. In response to the attacks, the Israeli army said it struck over 100 Hamas targets in the Gaza Strip overnight.
