PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

VAYELECH

1. The events of the last day of Moshe's life.
2. He encouraged the nation to conquer the Land of Canaan,
3. He publicly transferred the leadership to his successor, Yehoshua.
4. He commanded the mitzvah of Hakhel - gathering the nation together at the Bet Hamikdash on Sukkot at the conclusion of the Shemittah - sabbatical year.
5. Moshe writes a copy of the Torah and gives it to the Levi'im to keep it in the Aron Kodesh.

HAFTORAH

The Shabbat between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur is known as Shabbat Shuva or "Shabbat of Return (Repentance)." The name is a reference to the opening words of the week's haftorah, "Shuva Israel — Return O Israel." This haftorah is read in honor of the Ten Days of Repentance, the days between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. The prophet Hosea exhorts the Jewish people to "Return, O Israel, to the L-rd your G-d," encouraging them to repent sincerely and ask for G-d's forgiveness. Hosea urges the Jews to put their trust in G-d, not in Assyria, powerful horses or idols.

AIPAC Israel Update

U.S. Announces Closure of Palestinian Diplomatic Mission Over 'Refusal to Engage with Peace Efforts'

The Trump administration announced on Monday that it was shutting down the PLO diplomatic delegation in Washington, saying in a State Department statement that "the PLO has not taken steps to advance the start of direct and meaningful negotiations with Israel," as reported by Haaretz. The State Department said that the PLO leadership had instead "condemned a U.S. peace plan they have not yet seen and refused to engage with the U.S. government with respect to peace efforts and otherwise." The statement added that the decision was "also consistent with Administration and Congressional concerns with Palestinian attempts to prompt an investigation of Israel by the International Criminal Court." In addition to this announcement, Trump's National Security Adviser John Bolton said on Monday that the U.S. will shield Israel from any attempts to investigate its actions by the International Criminal Court. "While the Court welcomes the membership of the so-called 'State of Palestine,' it has threatened Israel, a liberal, democratic nation, with investigation into its actions to defend citizens from terrorist attacks in the West Bank and Gaza", Bolton said.
